




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Synchronous vs. asynchronous learning


- > Have students brainstorm on the whiteboard










Breakout rooms: have students think/pair/share

Breakout rooms: have students think/pair/share

- ➤ Have students think, pair, share
- > Have students collaborate on presentations
- ➤ Have a step-by-step tutorial using broadcast function
- > Have a "mixer" where students switch rooms
- ➤ Pair students based on individual needs
- > Remind students to call you with questions



Beyond: general zoom features

- ➤ Do a teaching observation
- ➤ Have a guest speaker
- ➤ Program in regular breaks
- ➤ Go old-school and show written answers on the camera
- ➤ Less is more! Cut down on text; use visual cues
- ➤ Utilize other online interactive websites/software







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
